The Most Holy Trinity

YEAR C | 12 June 2022

Dear sisters and brothers in Christ.

St John Damascene wrote of the Trinity in the following words:

"Think of the Father as a spring of life begetting the Son like a river, and the Holy Spirit like a sea, for the spring and the river and the sea are all one nature.

Think of the Father as a root, of the Son as a branch, and of the Spirit as a fruit, for the substance in these three is one.

The Father is a sun, with the Son as rays and the Holy Spirit as heat. But the Trinity surpasses by far every likeness and comparison".

The Doctrine of the Trinity has been at the heart of the Christian Faith since the earliest

John's Gospel makes that clear in today's Reading.

It is a Mystery of our Faith; and while we can reason our way through the understanding of God as One, yet relating to humanity in three ways as Father (Source of all Being), Son (Revelation of God), and Spirit (Unconditional Love of God)... it is still a 'leap into the dark', an Act of Faith that is demanded of us Christians.

But what is for sure is that our Loving and Almighty Creator God wants us to imitate the perfect love of the Trinity in our lives and in our interaction with our neighbour; and this will lead us one day to be immersed in the divine love of God for all eternity.

During today's celebration of the Trinity, let us ask our God to strengthen our Faith in this Mystery, so that we will live lives worthy of that unconditional Divine Love which is our destiny.





THE MOST HOLY TRINITY C

ENTRANCE Blessed be God the Father, and the Only

Begotten Son of God, and also the Holy Spirit, for

he has shown us his merciful love.

FIRST READING (Proverbs 8:22-31) The Wisdom of God cries aloud: The Lord created me when his purpose first unfolded, before the oldest of his works. From everlasting I was firmly set, from the beginning, before earth came into being. The deep was not, when I was born, there were no springs to gush with water. Before the mountains were settled, before the hills, I came to birth; before he made the earth, the countryside, or the first grains of the world's dust. When he fixed the heavens firm, I was there, when he drew a ring on the surface of the deep, when he thickened the clouds above, when he fixed fast the springs of the deep, when he assigned the sea its boundaries - and the waters will not invade the shore when he laid down the foundations of the earth, I was by his side, a master craftsman, delighting him day after day, ever at play in his presence, at play everywhere in his world, delighting to be with the children of humankind.

RESPONSE O Lord, our God, how wonderful your name in all the earth!

SECOND READING (Romans 5:1-5)

Through our Lord Jesus Christ, by faith we are judged righteous and at peace with God, since it is by faith and through Jesus that we have entered this state of grace in which we can boast about looking forward to God's glory. But that is not all we can boast about; we can boast about our sufferings. These sufferings bring patience, as we know, and patience brings perseverance, and perseverance brings hope, and this hope is not deceptive, because the love of God has been poured into our hearts by the Holy Spirit which has been given us.

GOSPEL ACCLAMATION

Alleluia, alleluia!

Glory to the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit: to God who is, who was, and who is to come. Alleluia!

GOSPEL (John 16:12-15)

Jesus said to his disciples:

'I still have many things to say to you but they would be too much for you now. But when the Spirit of truth comes he will lead you to the complete truth, since he will not be speaking as from himself but will say only what he has learnt; and he will tell you of the things to come. He will glorify me, since all he tells you will be taken from what is mine. **Everything the Father has is mine;** that is why I said: All he tells you will be taken from what is mine.'
